





STORM SUMMARY 1-31-19 & 2-1-19

Snow spread into the area 3-5pm and diminished to flurries 3-4am on 2-1. The flurries carried on during the morning hours on 2-1 with several little pockets that put down additional snow between 4-6am. Temperatures started out 5-9 degrees below zero at the onset of the snowfall and by the time snow ended readings were in the 6-9 degrees above zero. With bitter cold temperatures and the cold ground regular salt was not very effective. O'Hare measured 1.7 inches, MDW 1.7 inches, Romeoville 1.7 inches and Rockford 1.1 inches.
