## **ACTION ALERT**

Freezing rain has reached Peoria and will be spreading into the local area for the evening commute. One US model is running colder that the other models for tonight and hints at more snow than ice from I88 northward. Whenever any heavier precipitation moves over the area tonight it could flip the precipitation to sleet or snow, will depend on the radar at that point. Possible little lull in the activity from 8-10am Tuesday or just some drizzle followed by periods of light snow into early Wednesday am. Forecast at this point: 2-4" snow and sleet along and north of a line from Rockford to Waukegan, mainly 1" I90 and I88 in addition to .10 to .30 ice, after 9-11am Tuesday looking .5 to 1.5" of snow. Zero Tolerance crews will be dispatched and ready within each region for the beginning of today's precipitation.

For all 2" and over Multifamily complexes we will be monitoring activity and taking measurements to keep track of when and if thresholds are achieved. If your property does not reach over 2" inches you still may want to contact your account manager and request a salting application with the anticipated ice they are forecasting.
