





## STORM SUMMARY 2-20-19

Winter weather advisory was issued from 3am to 3pm. Fairly brief period of snow followed by a period of freezing rain and then drizzle and light rain late morning till late afternoon. Light snow spread back into the area 3-5am and went to freezing rain from south to north 7-9am. By late morning, precipitation was no longer freezing. Most areas had less than an inch of snow. Officially ORD had .2 snow, Rockford 1" and Romeoville .3". Plowing was needed in the Rockford, DeKalb, St. Charles, Sugar Grove and West Chicago areas. All other areas needed multiple rounds of salting and sidewalks had to be shoveled to remove the layer of ice that had accumulated. It was a very messy day and precipitation continued until around 10pm. The winds were strong but surfaces remained very wet. Zero tolerance crews were dispatched over night to deice all areas that experienced refreeze.
