





STORM SUMMARY 2-5 & 6-19

Ice storm warning from 6pm on 2-5 to 6am on 2-6. A brief period of sleet occurred 5-6pm followed by periods of freezing rain 6-7pm till nearly midnight. The ice storm warning was eventually canceled at 3am. .10 to .25 of ice was received on surfaces except in Chicago southward and out towards Joliet. Some drizzle occurred between 2-4am with temperatures nudging up to 32-34 degrees. Rockford had to trigger plowing operations as they had .8 sleet and .11 ice, Beach Park .25 ice ORD .03 ice, Aurora .12, West Chicago .13, Romeoville trace ice, Crystal Lake .4 sleet and .15 ice. Multiple rounds of salt were required; most areas received at least three full applications.
