ACTION ALERT

Similar to yesterday, pavement temperatures are currently running in the upper 30's and mid 30's in Rockford. These temperatures will come down with dusk and with the onset of this evening's precipitation. Much of the precipitation will occur in bands prior to 2-4am then more widespread rainfall sets in. Rockford, North and West suburbs will experience some light icing tonight with the Rockford area receiving the longest duration. DuPage, Cook and Will counties will most likely stay plain rain but we will monitor these areas. Zero tolerance crews will be dispatched before rush hour to be onsite as conditions worsen.

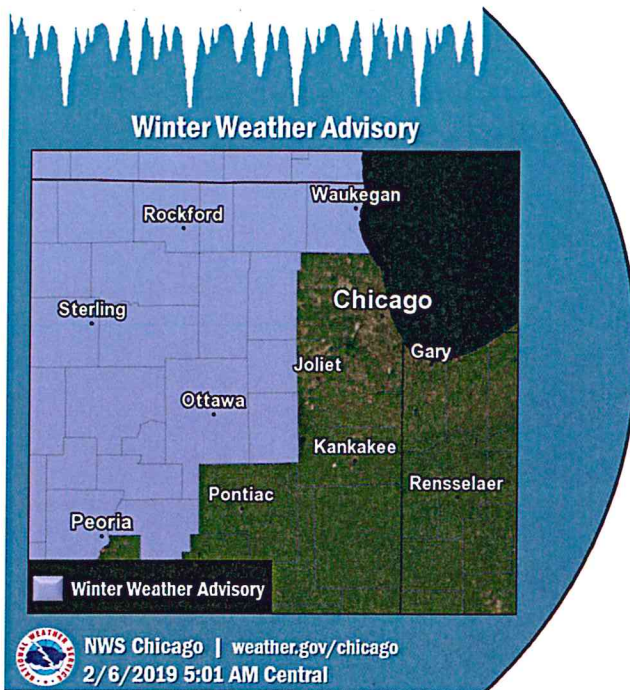

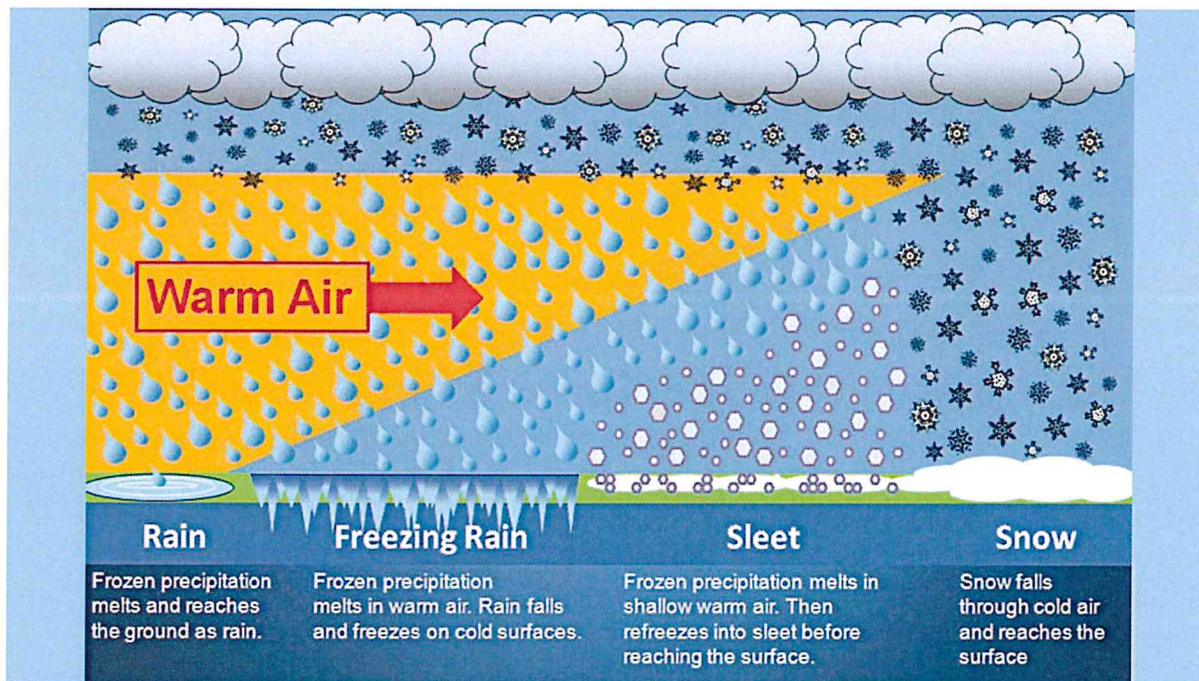
