## **ACTION ALERT**

Widespread dense fog will persist over much of northern Illinois and northwest Indiana until early afternoon. There is a slight chance of thunderstorms through early afternoon. Spotty freezing rain is possible in portions of northwest and north central Illinois. Strong westerly winds late this afternoon through this evening will gust up to 40 mph. Much colder air arriving later today may cause lingering moisture to freeze on untreated surfaces. Field managers will be monitoring surfaces as temperatures reach the freezing point and dispatch crews to areas in need of deicing treatments.
