ACTION ALERT

A quick passing system is expected to move through the area Sunday morning while temperatures will be below freezing. If the system tracks further north we might see some of the higher totals listed below. Brief snowfall rates up to 1 inch or more per hour are possible in heavier snow bands. This accumulating snow will primarily be near the I80 corridor, where swaths of 2-4" is expected. We will be dispatching zero tolerance crews for deicing of walkways and parking lots as conditions warrant.
