





STORM SUMMARY 4-14-19

A late season storm produced very heavy wet snow across the area. Precipitation stayed more of a mixture for Northwest Indiana and south of I80. As much as 6-8 inches were reported in a narrow corridor from DeKalb County to Palatine. Amounts for much of the area were in the 2 to 5 inch range. There was some convection embedded in the snow which aided in the variability of the snow amounts. Also the far south suburbs had rain mixed in with the snow for a longer period. Some areas ended up with much more on the grass than on the asphalt especially south of North Ave. Officially, O'Hare had 5.4 inches which was a record for April 14th. This brought the season total to 47.0 Inches. Rockford had 2.9 inches for a season total of 54.1 inches.
