



STORM SUMMARY 4-27-19

Another very late storm system produced some additional measurable snow to northern Illinois. There was more accumulation on grass and elevated surfaces compared to the pavement and sidewalks. Pavement temperatures and especially the sub surface temperatures were warmer during this system compared to the previous event. Plowing and shoveling was necessary in certain regions and all zero tolerance properties received a deicing application. The official snowfall was 2.5 inches at O'Hare which pushed the monthly total to 7.9 inches and the season total 49.5 inches.
