ACTION ALERT

Similar to the Rockford area this morning, we will see more periods of mixed rain and snow tonight into early Thursday night. We will be checking surfaces Wednesday morning and service where necessary. Sidewalks and elevated surfaces have the best chance of accumulation or slushing up but most will be on grass surfaces. Thursdays activity will be mostly during the day and will also help keep most accumulation to grass surfaces. As most clients are still outside their normal seasonal service dates, we will be monitor surfaces for all our 24 hour emergency facilities such as hospitals.
