





STORM SUMMARY 10-31-19

Rain mixed with sleet and snow before change to snow 4-5am. The snow lasted till late afternoon. Temperatures hung around freezing most of the daylight hours although pavement temps ran warmer which resulted in the accumulation mainly on grass and elevated surfaces. Officially O'Hare had 3.4 inches which was another record and for the month 4.6 inches which ranks as the 2nd snowiest October on Record. Rockford had 3.1 inches or 4.2 for the month which also ranked as the 2nd snowiest October on record.
