



STORM SUMMARY 11-13 & 14-19

Some light snow and flurries at times occurred after 7-9pm for areas mainly north of I88. The activity shriveled up around 1-3am on the 14th. Most of the accumulation was near and north of I90 with mostly trace amounts around I88. Residual left over from the previous system combined with temperatures in the mid to upper 20s took care of much of the snow south of Sterns Rd-Eastward. Areas North of this line did need to put down another application of salt and specific towns like Cary and Crystal Lake even had to plow. Officially O'Hare had .2 which raised the season total to 8.3 inches. Rockford had .8 which increased the season total to 8.8 inches.
