ACTION ALERT

Leading edge of precipitation on radar is coming up on Cedar Rapids Iowa City, Burlington. Some of this has reached the ground in Iowa and some of it has not. That may very well be the case locally as well as the lower levels of the atmosphere are quite dry. Listed below are the most likely accumulation possibilities for specific areas but there could be a shift a little further south or north so nothing is etched in stone at this point. The best chance for a salting application to be needed will be mainly north of I90.
