ACTION ALERT

Light snow will spread in from the South tonight. The window of opportunity is fairly small, only a 3-6 hour window. The latest model run seems to push the northern edge of the snow area a little further north into southern Wisconsin. This should be just a salting event for most of our regions other than our southern region down towards the Morris, Manhattan and to Monee line.
