ACTION ALERT

Scattered Flurries and light snow into this evening and then snow 8pm this evening into early Tuesday morning. The models seem to show the heaviest activity will be after 12-2am and till 6-7am. The majority of the accumulating snow will be focused from I80 northward. May have some blowing snow in open areas overnight and early Tuesday as winds will be 15-30 mph with gust of 33-37 mph. Most likely plowing operations will need to be triggered as the snow accumulates but we may also see multiple deicing applications with this event especially due to these heavy winds. Zero Tolerance accounts are already being serviced with a deicing application as currently there is a light coating over most properties.
