





## STORM SUMMARY 1-11 & 12-20

A powerful system brought an assortment of precipitation to the area starting with heavy rainfall on 1-10. Rainfall amounts of 1-2.5 inches fell. The heavy rainfall diminished to some drizzle, light rain, and light freezing drizzle and sleet during the morning of 1-11. Pavement temperatures hung right around freezing for most areas until 2-4 pm on 1-11. Elevated surfaces were the most susceptible to icing and glazing prior to 2-3 pm in the north suburbs. Precipitation switched to snow for all areas 4-6 pm on 1-11. There was a brief period of moderate to heavy snow between 7-8 pm and light snow gradually diminished by 1 am on 1-12. The snow amounts were quite variable from one spot to the next. Rockford had .25 of ice, Aurora .03, West Chicago .04. Officially O'Hare had 2.1 inches, Rockford 2.1 and Romeoville .4".
