ACTION ALERT

Currently there is the potential of some freezing rain and light snow tonight between 7-9 PM until 5-6 AM Monday morning which could actually come in two waves. With this incoming precipitation along with refreeze from the melting that occurred during Sunday, crews will be performing a deicing application to all parking lots and sidewalk surfaces. We will also be completing our normal cleanup & snow relocation operations during the overnight hours tonight for all our retail, commercial and hospital/medical facilities. All our apartment complex and hotels your day after cleanup will be taking place Monday during the day from 9 AM to 3 PM as these lots remained full throughout the day on Sunday.
