





STORM SUMMARY 1-15-20

A Winter Weather Advisory was issued for 6am to 12pm on Wednesday. Some freezing drizzle, light freezing rain and with a few flakes mixed in, occurred mainly from Dekalb to Waukegan after that 6pm timeframe. South of that line, the drizzle was slow to move in and did not do so until after 9am. After 9am most pavements and air temperatures were above freezing. Due to the risk for some light glazing and freezing drizzle and along with this occurring during the morning rush hour commute; all of our zero tolerance and icy condition accounts were serviced just prior to the precipitation arriving to the area. This allowed for us to service everything in a timely manor and create a safe environment for the start of the work day.
