





## STORM SUMMARY 1-17 & 18-20

A storm system tracked from the Rockies to Wisconsin. This system produced a wide variety of weather for the area. First there was a period of snow which switched over to freezing rain and freezing drizzle and eventually over to plain light rain and drizzle after 3-5am on 1-18-20. Snow amounts ranged from 2 to 5" inches along with .1 to .25" of ice. Officially O'Hare had 3.1" inches, Rockford 3.2" inches and Romeoville 1.9" inches. Freezing rain totals were West Chicago .28, Waukegan .28, Rockford .27, Aurora Airport .27, ORD .26, Wheeling .24, Valparaiso .23 and Midway .12.
