ACTION ALERT

Snow is just currently breaking into the area from west to east. We may see an hour or 2 of moderate snow this evening. Snow will likely become mixed with sleet and freezing rain after 10-11pm and should change to freezing rain and rain 1-3am. Snow accumulations we will be in the 1-3" range south of I80 and on average 2-4" snow and sleet north of that line. Precipitation should be mainly light rain and drizzle by 6-7am Saturday and precipitation goes back to snow showers after 11am-12pm Saturday. Temperatures by 6-7am should be 33-36 degrees. As we approach Saturday evening we will be heading into a deep freeze for a few days where we won't see any relief until Wednesday. All zero tolerance crews have been dispatched and will be arriving to sites within the next hour.

Impacts:

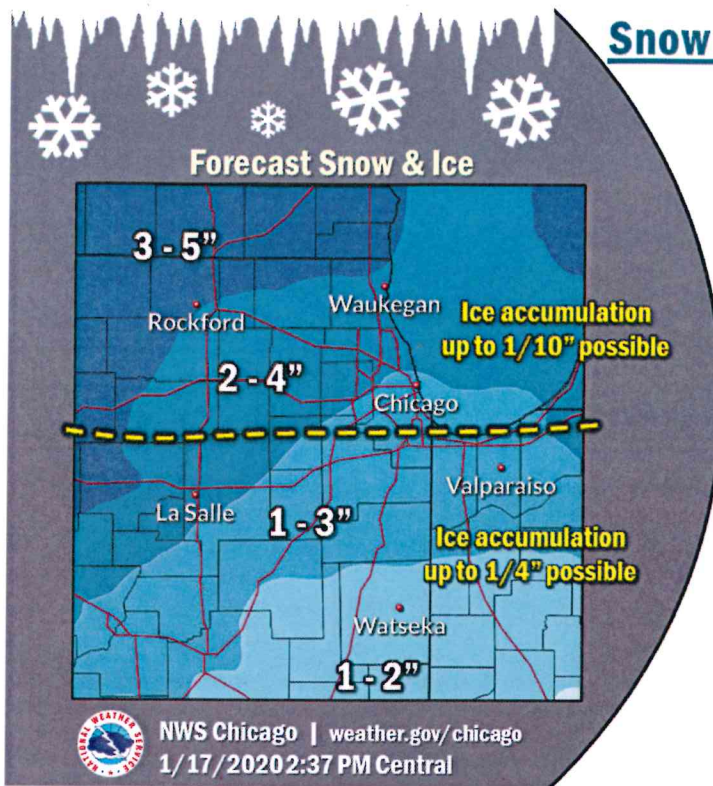
Hazardous travel during PM commute. Low visibility. Slippery walking conditions.

Blowing/drift possible north in evening.

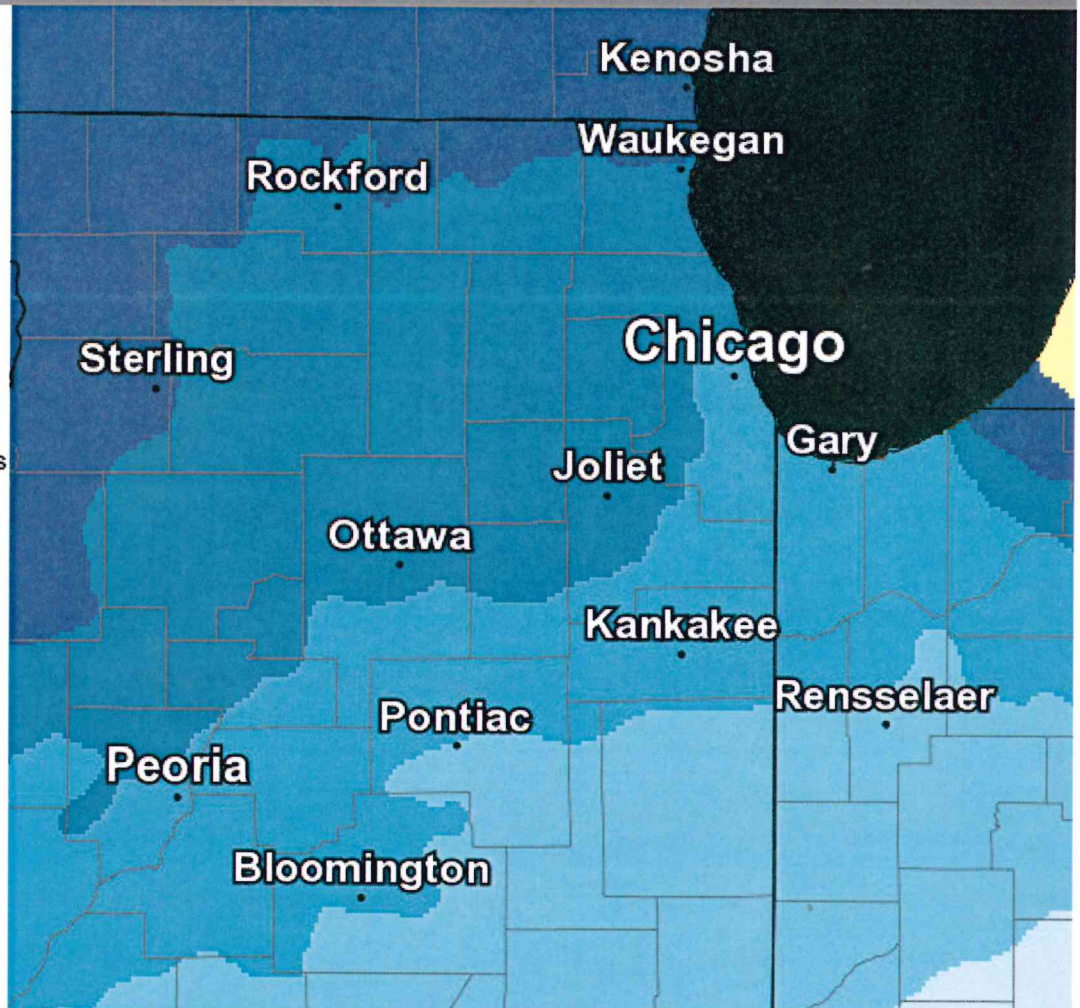
Actions
