





STORM SUMMARY 1-22 & 23-20

This was a long duration event that began prior to midnight on 1-22 and lasted thru most of 1-25. There was a wide variety of precipitation during this event. Much of the daylight hours each day featured more melting than accumulation because of a combination of air and pavement temperatures along with precipitation type. Light snow mixed with rain 5-7pm and turned to light rain and drizzle from 9-11pm with some snow mixed in at times through midnight. There was <1" of snow with this snow during the early evening in the north and west suburbs prior to the changeover. The first phase of the system produced 1.6 inches in Rockford, .9 inches O'Hare, 1.1 inches Romeoville and 1.2 inches MWD.
