



STORM SUMMARY 1-24 & 25 & 26-20

Mixed light rain and snow turned to light rain and drizzle 2-4am and this continued for the work day. Steadier light rain moved into the area during the evening and early night. Rain changed to snow 6-8pm Rockford and 9-11pm Sugar Grove to O'Hare and after 11pm further south. The main band of snow got pushed away from areas east of Route 59 after midnight till 5-7am on the 25th. Light snow continued for much of the day before diminishing to light rain and drizzle by evening and ending by midnight. Once again because of pavement and air temperatures above freezing there wasn't much accumulation after 10am and most surfaces were just wet after the morning's early and late salting/deicing treatments. Clean up and relocation services were performed overnight on the 25th into the 26th to prepare places safely for Sunday morning. Snow totals were 3-6 inches around Rockford. Officially Rockford had 4.3 inches, O'Hare .4 inches, MDW .5 inches, Romeoville .7 inches. The overall 72 hours storm totals were: Rockford 6.0 inches, O'Hare 1.2 inches, Romeoville 1.8 inches.
