ACTION ALERT

Pavement temperatures are running around 40 degrees but will be dropping down to around 30-32 degrees during the early Tuesday morning hour. Precipitation is forecasted for late tonight into Tuesday morning that may favor freezing drizzle rather than flakes but only trace amounts are expected. We will have our regional managers out checking zero tolerance properties during the 3am-6am timeframe incase surfaces slick up and salt/deicing product needs to be applied.
