ACTION ALERT

Radar shows some light snowfall over northeast Iowa, eastern Iowa into western Illinois and southwest Wisconsin. The activity is nudging eastward. The intermediate Euro model increased the chances for some snowfall for Rockford and northeast and north Central IL while the US models still downplays the precipitation chances particularly form Lake and northeast Cook County. We will increase the chance for some snow flakes for the area as a whole. Amounts look to be under an inch for most areas and if the Euro model verifies the entire area will need to receive a salting application. Beginning time for Rockford 10-11pm and Chicago area 11pm-1am, activity is still expected to diminish by 7-8am Saturday.
