



STORM SUMMARY 1-3 & 4-20

Light snow showers and flurries began in Rockford around 10pm and by midnight there was .3" accumulation on the grass with pavement remaining wet. The snow showers shifted into the Chicago area after midnight. Heaviest intensity of snow was over southern DeKalb County southward into La Salle County and eastward thru Kendall, Gundy, Will counties and into northwest Indiana. Even in the areas where around 2" inches accumulated, pavements remained mainly slushy or had under 1" inch of pavement accumulation. There were some 3-4 inches in La Salle County. Pavement temperatures hovered around 32.5 during the early morning hours on 1/4/20 so there was concern that surfaces could slicken up around daybreak 5-6am, many of our zero tolerance properties were treated as a precaution as the areas that did become slippery then had product down to create a safe environment. Officially O'Hare had .5", Rockford .3", Romeoville 1.8".
