ACTION ALERT

We will have another round of wet snow tonight which will diminish to some flurries and drizzle after 4-6am. Pavement temperatures are running warmer than yesterday in the lower 40's and temperatures tonight should also be slightly warmer. With the residual we have down from this morning's application and the warmer temperatures we should be ok for surfaces to not ice up but we still can not rule out some accumulation mainly between the midnight and 4am timeframe. We will have our regional managers out overnight to observe properties and dispatch trucks and sidewalks where necessary.
