





STORM SUMMARY 2-25 & 26-20

Light snow spread into the area from south to north 3-6p on 2-25. The snow was mixed with rain initially far south suburbs at the start. Temperatures both air and pavement temps remained above freezing past 1-2 am on 2-26 as most paved surfaces remained just wet while snow accumulated on elevated surfaces. Surfaces did slip into the upper 20s 4-6 am which allowed some black ice to form on surfaces along with some accumulation. Snow diminished to flurries for much of the area by 7-9am for the Chicago area. These flurries lasted till 8-9pm on the 26th. Parking lots and streets for our properties located in the south suburbs needed plowing along with salting and some lots further north needed partial plowing to handle wind drift areas. All properties received a full deicing of lots and sidewalks. The snow totals for 2-25 were .7 O'Hare, Romeoville .5, MDW 1.5 and trace at Rockford. The final totals for the 2 days were 1.7 inches ORD, 2.7 MDW 1.4 Romeoville and a trace at Rockford. The season totals are now: 26.9 ORD, 28.6 Rockford and 21.8 Romeoville.
