ACTION ALERT

It's been a few weeks since the moisture and overnight lower temperatures have aligned. We are looking for a system to move into the area as light rain and snow Sunday afternoon. This should take the form of mainly light snow by Sunday night. There is the potential this could produce an inch or so mainly on the grass and elevated surfaces Sunday night into early Monday morning. We will have our regional managers out monitoring all zero tolerance and icy condition properties and we'll service sidewalks, parking garages and parking lots surfaces if conditions warrant.
