ACTION ALERT

The next system moves in during the overnight hours starting in Rockford between 1-3am and 2-4am for Chicago. This will be a narrow band of light snow with some mixed rain at times from around the IL/WI border south to around I80. Pavement temperatures will be right around 32 degrees so it will be tough to predict if anything will accumulate on evaluated and paved surfaces. We will have our regional managers out checking surfaces overnight and will trigger services if conditions warrant.
