ACTION ALERT

Hopefully winter's last gasp will occur late tonight into Friday morning. We are anticipating snow to enter the area late tonight and wrap up later Friday morning. Snow rates will be heavier after 2-3am to about 6am Friday. Since the heavier activity will be occurring during the coldest part of our overnight hours there is a good chance that this heavy activity will overcome the warm surface temperatures and we will see accumulation on the pavement areas and not just elevated surfaces such as parking garages and sidewalks. Further south where they will be receiving the higher snow totals we will most likely have all our machines running for full plowing operations. We will be servicing all zero tolerance and icy conditions properties as conditions worsen.
