ACTION ALERT

A cold front pushes through that area late tonight. Showers are just entering the area and look to exit around 2-3 am Friday morning. These showers may end as snow showers during the early Friday morning hours. The winds are scheduled to increase and the wet surfaces should dry up but we cannot rule out puddles and elevated surfaces producing some black ice if the drying effect is not successful. We will be sending out our regional managers to monitor our zero tolerance accounts and apply deicing material if necessary.
