ACTION ALERT

Snow is set to arrive between 2-4:30 am Tuesday morning turning steady between that 4-6am timeframe. The accumulating snow will be in this first 2-3 hours of starting before turning lighter as we head through the daytime hours. This precipitation will mix with rain as the temperatures rise and by mid to late morning it should change over to all rain by 12pm-2pm. We will see less on the pavement due to the warm ground temperatures. All our zero tolerance crews will be dispatched during the early morning hours to service accounts and will continue doing rounds during the morning rush hour.
